St Peter's Radway Restoration and Re-Ordering Project

As many of you will know, a small group of people have been working on some proposals for the restoration and re-ordering of our village church.

We are driven by our overall need to make the church building safe for all users, and sustainable. We need to protect the current exhibition and secure its future. We also need to look to the future ministry of the church in the village, so are challenged to provide a welcoming, vibrant and accessible environment for worshippers and visitors of all ages, from the village and the wider community. In order to do this, we need to repair and stabilize the roof, improve the facilities we offer both worshippers and visitors and make provision for accessible worship for all age groups. We also want to enhance and expand the exhibition, improve the bell ringing space and improve access to the building.
