Radway's Church Roof Restoration - Important information

As you are aware, Radway's church roof is failing. Without urgent replacement work, the church is very likely to close. It will be left to continue to decay, probably wrapped in blue plastic. Let's not allow this to happen!

We are applying to the National Lottery Heritage Fund for a grant to replace the roof. Competition for money is likely to be challenging as church building maintenance is a widespread and increasing problem.

To greatly improve our chances of being awarded the necessary funding, we need to know how you feel about the church, the Battlefield Exhibition and the planned roof restoration. This information will be used, without attribution to any respondent, to help build the information the National Lottery requires.

We have created a survey to gather this information, and the online version can be accessed via QR code.
